<b>SUMMARY OF DUTIES: Air Weapons Officer</b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Positioned at an automated radarscope, responsible for directing fighter aircraft during intercepts, combat tactics, and refueling operations.</li> <li>2. The job requires the ability to maintain situational awareness in dynamic, fluid situations and the ability to communicate to aircraft and senior officers rapidly, clearly, and effectively.</li> <li>3. The ability to lead and work effectively with a technical work force is essential.</li> <li>4. Other duties: Perform and manage ABM operations functions and activities; provide effective control of assigned forces; plan, organize, and direct operations, including airspace management and data link operations; supervise mission crew activities; execute the published Air Tasking Order.</li> <li>5. Selected individuals will become a member of WADS Combat Operations (DOC Division).</li> <li>6. Professional growth will lead to the supervisory positions of Senior Director, Air Surveillance Officer, Interface Control Officer, and/or Mission Crew Commander.</li> <li>7.
