All current members of the Washington Air National Guard and those eligible to join

INITIAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The following criteria must be met as of closeout date of this announcement, (unless otherwise noted), to be considered:

- Open to all AFSCs. Applicant not possessing the 1C5X1 AFSC must be eligible to crosstrain into the 1C5X1 AFSC (ex. ASVAB score of 55 General, PULHES, etc.)
- Meet ANG fitness standards IAW AFI 36-2905 with a score of 75 or above (*applies only to current members of the USAF, USAFR or ANG*)
- Possess or be able to obtain a **SECRET** security clearance

SUMMARY OF DUTIES

Operates aerospace control and warning systems equipment at the Western Air Defense Sector. Interprets and reacts to radarscope presentation, performs surveillance, identification, data link, and/or data management functions. Participates as a crew-member and/or performs training, standardization and evaluation, and other staff duty functions. Member may be required to work rotating shifts in a 24/7 work environment. HQ WA ANG policy requires initial AGR tours for 2-3 years with potential for renewal at the end of current tour. Subsequent AGR tours are limited to a maximum of no more than four years.

ELEMENTS

The following elements are considered essential for successful performance in this position. Response to the Elements is voluntary, however written response to each of the following Elements will ensure that specialized experience is recognized.

• Knowledge of relationship within and among aerospace control and warning systems.

- Knowledge of EA equipment, capabilities, and limitations.
- Knowledge of fixed command and control system characteristics and radar console presentations.
- Knowledge in data display and computer input equipment.
- Knowledge of Air Defense Sector is desirable.

- 6) Point Credit Summary (PCARS) from the vMPF. Print "View All", minus the PCARS definitions and FAQ pages (only applies to current members of the USAFR or ANG).
- 7) Current Report of Individual Fitness (only applies to current members of the USAF, USAFR or ANG).
- 8) AF Form 422 (not required if current WA ANG AGR member).
- 9) Response to Job Elements (not required, but highly encouraged).
