Demonstrated ability to prepare written reports and to prepare/present briefings. Commissioning applicants must be eligible for Air National Guard Commission (contingent upon successful attainment of a Bachelor's Degree by closing date of the announcement) with the AFOQT score required for this AFSC. Must be under the age of 40 prior to graduating Total Force Officer Training (TFOT). Must possess or be eligible to obtain a TOP SECRET/SCI security clearance prior to attending technical training.</p>

Lead an Intelligence team and oversee the sensitive compartmented information program. Oversee multiple Intelligence agendas, to include internal & external training plans, Intelligence Oversight, & SCIF security. Lead the overall Sector threat awareness & readiness posture, ensuring Sector leadership and unit personnel are current on imminent threats to enhance BCC combat readiness. Organize and lead intelligence production utilizing analysis and advanced SCI applications to support BCC leadership and operators. Train intelligence and systems personnel to provide intelligence production capability in support of the unit's missions. Manage secret compartmentalized information facility resources to further the squadron's mission and training goals.</p>
